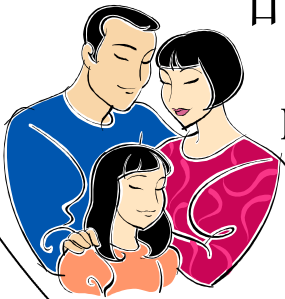

Fold in fourths so that title page “Mid-Autumn Festival” in on top.



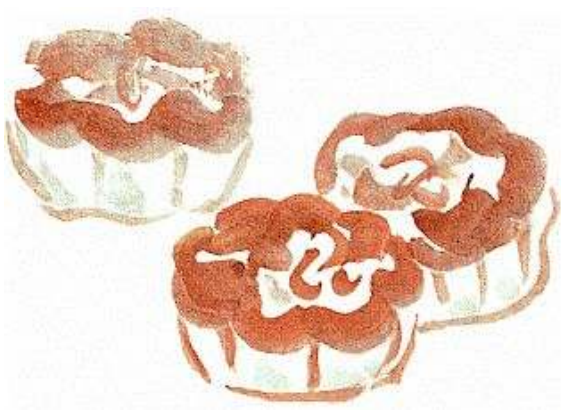
