## Write with

- Dotters
- White crayon on white paper; then paint with watercolors
- Oil pastels
- Paint
- Sidewalk chalk
- Window pens
- Eraser (use old magazine pages)

## Write on

- Sandpaper
- White board
- Chalkboard
- Sidewalk
- Windows or glass doors
- Mirrors
- Bathtub wall
- Paper taped to the bottom of table (Sistene chapel style)

## Spell with

- Letter tiles
- Alphabet stickers
- Letter punches
- Letter rubber stamps
- Alphabet stencils
- Alphabet cookie cutters
- Magnetic letters
- Lettered clothespins
- Letters cut from old magazines

## Form letters with

- String, twine, yarn, ribbon
- Pipe cleaners
- Playdough or clay
- Toothpicks
- Packing peanuts
- Building blocks

- Jump letter to letter — letters written on floor/sidewalk or on papers
- Use sign language
- Type the correct spelling
